Do not bend the privacy filter. Do not use an abrasive cloth to clean the surface of the privacy filter.


To Clean & Maintain

Remove the filter from the device before cleaning. Clean with microfiber cloth to wipe away fingerprints, smudges and dust.


To remove dirt and dust, wash the filter adhesive under cold water then air dry before re-applying.




Clean the screen with microfiber cloth.




Align the filter with the bezel and firmly press on the adhesive.
